Applicants are high school juniors (Class of 2015) who met the academic and athletic criteria required by the application, which included among the requirements:

- A minimum of 3.5 grade point average (4.0 scale, calculated from the first semester of 9th grade through and including the first semester of the 11<sup>th</sup> grade year.
- A minimum single test composite on SAT of **1800** (out of 2400) or ACT of **27**.
- Must be an active rower or coxswain in a MSRA member program, who:
  - Rowed in the finals (Sunday race) of the MSRA Championship of their 10<sup>th</sup> grade year, or
  - Rowed at SRAA, US Junior Nationals, or Junior Worlds
